Bring a pre-ready primed canvas with you. Maybe no bigger than 16x20" to start.

Everything you need can be bought at Michaels in North Dartmouth, Ma.

Middle size tubes of these oils: Windsor Newton - Titanium White / Oxide of Chromium ( Green) ,

Cobalt Blue (Hue) / French Ultramarine / Van dyke Brown / Burnt Umber .

> Burnt Sienna / Yellow Ochre / Transparent Iron Oxide / Alizarin Crimsom / Cadmium Yellow Light / Cadmium Red. Those are all the colors you will ever need.

Paints and other supplies I get at <http://riversideart.com> in Somerset you'll get a great artist discount if you mention me (John Gamache).

Brushes get at Michaels " Simply Simmon \$3.99 ea. all sizes or Royal & Langnickel a lot of those are the same price.

Get Mineral Spirits odorless at Home Depot : Gallon= \$14 and change ( the clear stuff not the white milky stuff you get in the white plastic container).

Need a palette, metal palette knife, a roll of paper towels for cleaning.
