Clay

Work with low-fire clay inspired by our flexible weekly themes. Younger students learn basic hand building techniques so they get familiar with clay as a unique medium. Older students will experience wheel throwing projects under an instructor's guidance.

2D and 3D: Digital Arts, Multimedia and Sculpture

2D will explore drawing, painting, collage using a variety of media. 3D will create sculptural objects that have depth and dimension using recycled materials and other materials. Weekly guidelines and themes are provided with the class listing, however, we are flexible and experienced enough to focus workshops based on the interests of our students.
