Under the Sea: Watercolor Resist Paintings

Materials:

Paint	Variations of blue and green Washes <i>(A Wash is thinned paint: a little paint + a lot of water)</i>
Paint brushes	Large, Medium, Small
Palette	<i>Use a palette with separate sections for each color to keep the washes from mixing together</i>
Water Container	Old plastic container
Pencil & Eraser	For drawing your underwater animals
Oil Pastels	Full range of colors & white
Table Salt	<i>(From your kitchen)</i>
Watercolor Paper	large sheet cut in half or 2 smaller sheets. <i>(Use the size you have)</i>

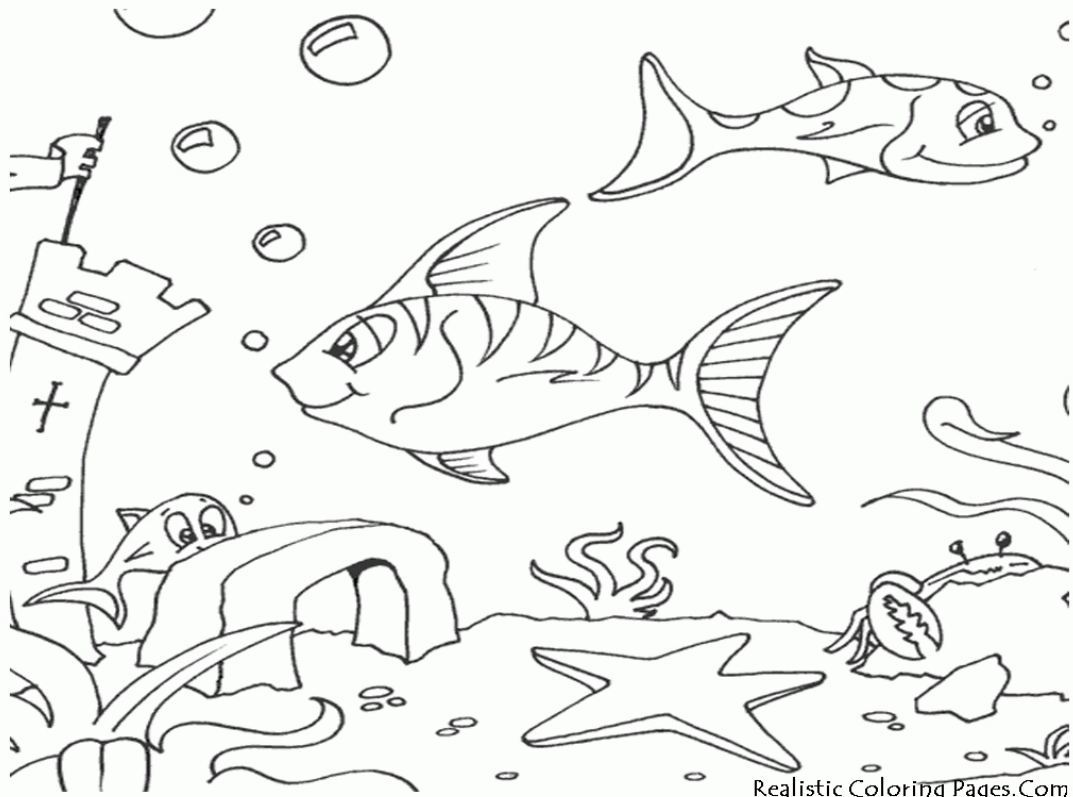
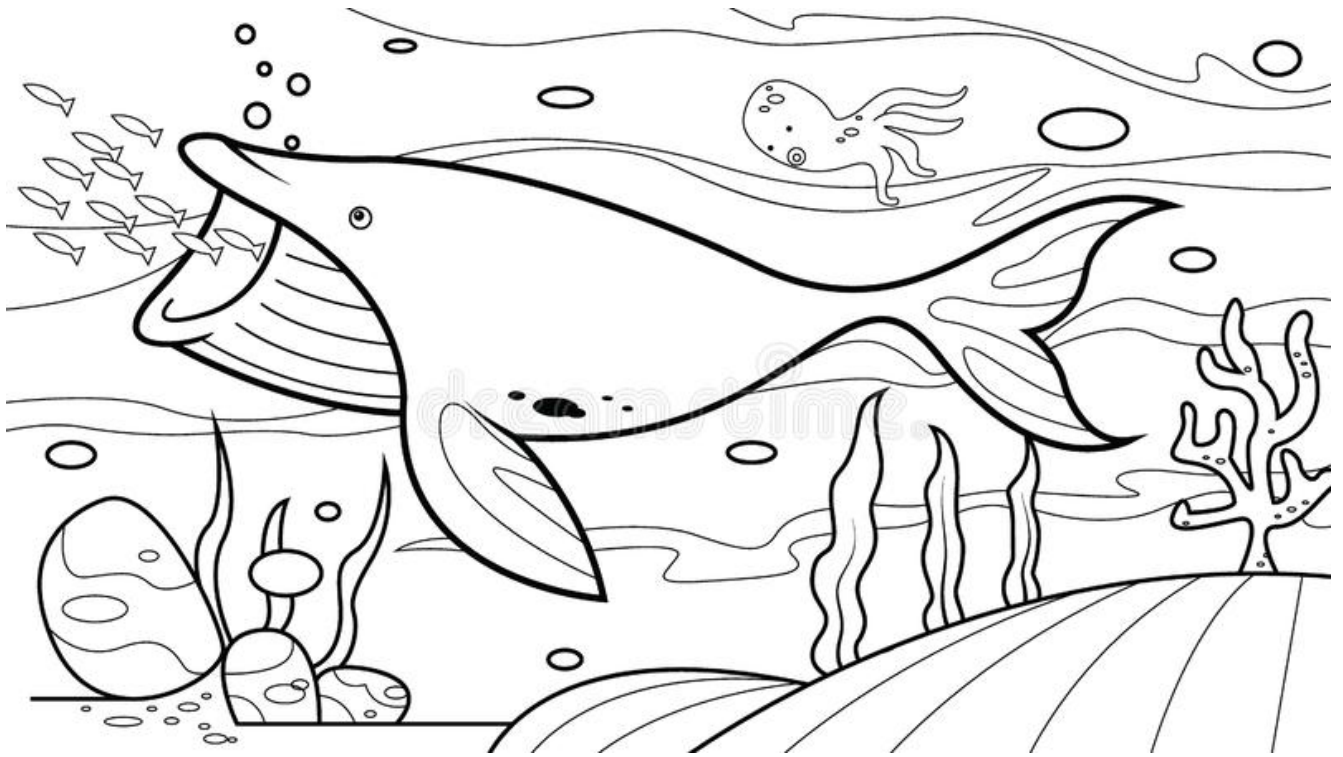

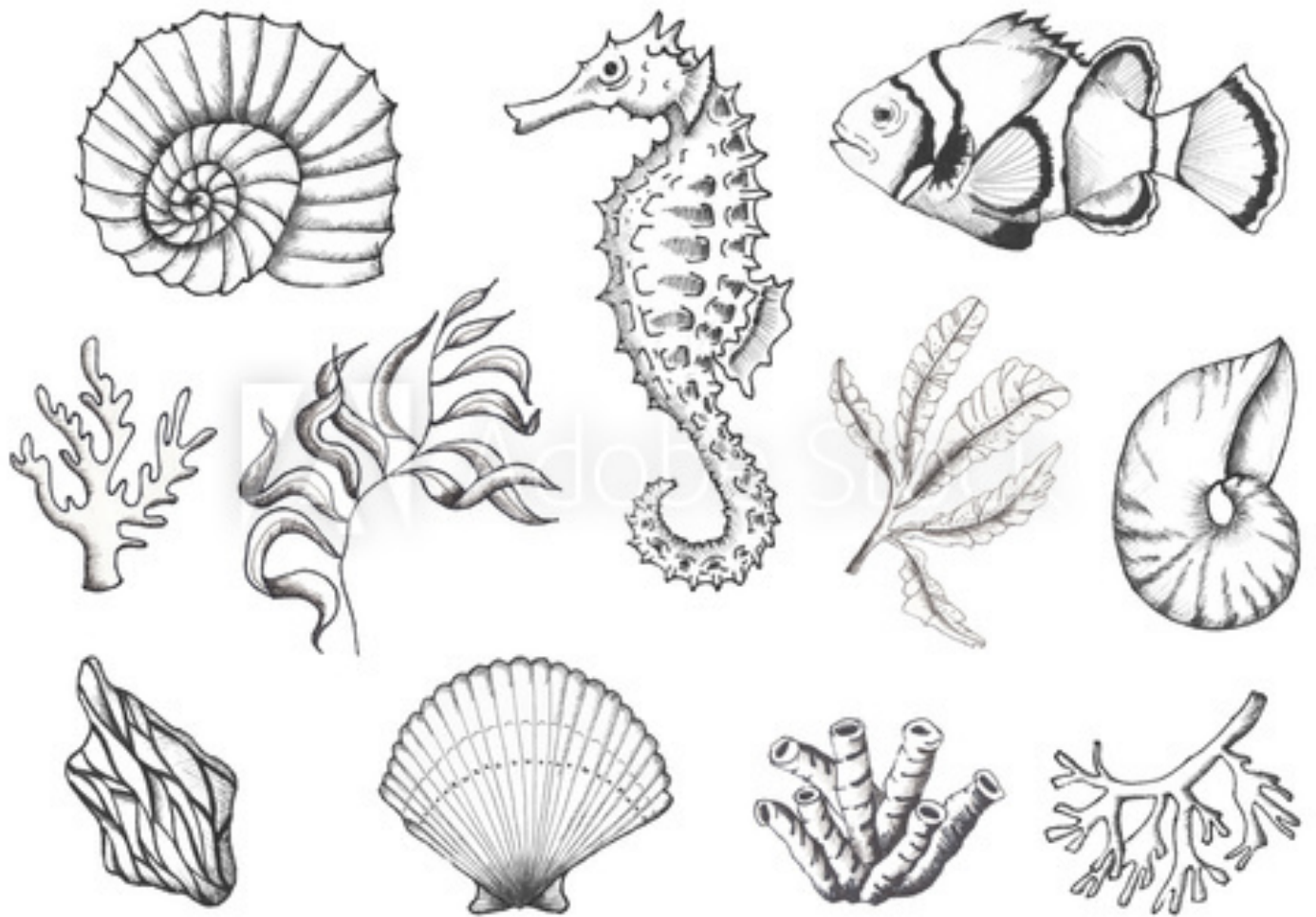
