### **“Frederick Douglass Portrait” Part 1**

#### **Materials:**

<b>B/W coloring page</b>	Portrait of Frederick Douglass
<b>1 Canvas board</b>	9:x12” or 8”x10”
<b>Acrylic Paint</b>	Primary colors & white
<b>Paintbrush</b>	Small
<b>Sponge</b>	A small piece of sponge
<b>Scissors</b>	To cut out portrait & quote
<b>Glue</b>	Glue stick or White glue

#### **Follow Video on Frederick Douglass Portrait**

**Step 1.** Take your Frederick Douglass coloring page and cut off the quote at the bottom. Put aside for later.

**Step 2.** Use the impressionist painting technique to paint inside the lines of the portrait of Frederick Douglass. Feel free to express yourself with color. Let dry

**Step 3.** Cut your painted portrait out and put aside
