Lesson: Freedom Trail Part 2

“Freedom Trail” Part 2 (Underground Railroad)

Materials:

Oil Pastels	Colored pencils/crayons or markers
Pencil & Eraser	For sketching & drawing
Paper (<i>Drawing paper</i>)	second half of 1 Large 18”x24” sheet
Pencil, Eraser	For sketching
Scissors	For cutting out individual drawings

Follow Video on Freedom Trail Part 2

Step 1. Choose at least 3 ‘Dangers’ and 3 ‘Safe refuge areas’ that Freedom seekers encountered on their escape to freedom. On the second half of your drawing paper, draw with your pencils small individual drawings of each, including your Freedom Seeker and New Bedford. (You can draw buildings or landmarks of New Bedford as one drawing or you can just write in bold letters “New Bedford” or “Freedom in New Bedford”. Also draw a large star for the Northern Star.

Step 2. Color in your drawings (for these small drawings, colored pencils and crayons may be easier to control than oil pastels (you can outline with black pen - optional)

Step 3. Now cut out your drawings leaving a small area under your drawing. Fold this small area upward – this will allow the drawing to stand up in a 3-D effect. Apply glue to the folded areas and stick wherever you choose on your Freedom Trail. (Follow my instruction in video)

Step 4. Label each drawing on your drawing paper and cut and glue them down next to the corresponding drawings. Or if you have space you can label them right on the drawings. Make any final additions or improvements and your Freedom Trail is completed.
