## SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAM

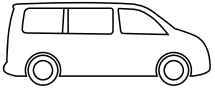


Established in 1995, over 33,000 youth have engaged with the artMOBILE learning artistic and inventive instruction with quality art supplies in area parks, housing facilities, partnering organizations, and cultural events. This outreach program continues to be a free and accessible source of creativity thanks to donor support.

artMOBILE visits 20 sites per week and has a program duration of 9 consecutive weeks in July and August. At many of the locations we visit, several in tandem with New Bedford Parks & Recreation's "Play in the Park and Summer Food Program," and the **New Bedford Public School Free Meal Program**. We offer children structured and engaging activities for the better part of their summer.
